Weekly Devotion!

Do you really trust God?

Jeremiah 29:11-13-"For I know plans I have for you,' declares the Lord, 'plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future. Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all of your heart."

Like many of you, I have had multiple opportunities to play the trust game. This is where a partner stands behind you while you fall into their arms. This game requires trust that your partner will catch you when you fall. This is similar to what God is asking of us.

The scriptures tell us that He is always with us. It is up to us to trust that He is there and live accordingly. He will not leave us.

We can have confidence knowing that He is always there and has plans for each of our lives.

When you are considering a major life change, the most important action you can take is one that is most often skipped: invite Him to lead you. LUKE CHAPTER 3-4

Doug Trudell Sr teaching - Luke 3:4

John the Baptist was the forerunner to Jesus, He preached the coming of the Messiah and He preached the words prophesied by Isaiah, Prepare ye the way of the Lord.

John was paving a way or a path for the Lord Jesus Christ to come, someone better and greater than he was.

Many came to be baptized by John the "Baptist" (this was not his denomination, but his profession)

He preached to the group of people, tax collectors, religious folks, soldiers and He calls them a Brood of Vipers. This is illustrated a group of hatchling snakes vicious and hungry.

He preaches tax collectors, don't be crooks... Soldiers, don't be to harsh...

John is preaching for us to do what is good and right in the eyes of the Lord.

He is preaching repentance and salvation – the coming of Jesus Christ.

He then makes a profound statement, I baptize with water but there comes one who will baptize you with Holy Spirit and fire.

Many thought he may be the messiah but he cleared the air of that. He was not the one. He preached of the coming "ONE."

John was eventually thrown into prison for preaching the good news of Jesus Christ and later beheaded because of his stance on Herod divorcing his wife, and marrying his brothers wife and their life of evil.

Herod's wife wanted Johns head on a platter.

Moving on to chapter 4 we find the beginning of Jesus ministry where He fasted and was tempted by the enemy in the desert. This marked the beginning of His Ministry on earth.
